Students who have an interest or background in thermodynamics, psychrometrics, fluid mechanics, indoor air quality, energy, building automation or controls, heating, ventilating, refrigeration or air conditioning (HVAC) principles are invited to apply. If you are in your junior or senior year, please submit the following:

- Cover letter stating how receiving this scholarship will help you in your education which may lead to a career in the building sciences, energy or HVAC areas.
- Resume of your relevant classes and/or work experience relating to these areas.
- List of classes in these areas that you have completed or are planning to take.

Please submit this application package, signed by your academic advisor (cover letter), to the Utah ASHRAE Student Activities Chair (see contact info below). The deadline for receiving these applications is March 3, 2011. The Utah ASHRAE chapter Board of Governors will review the applications and select two or three successful students to be awarded the scholarships. We encourage all applicants to attend the ASHRAE Student Night event.
